Cain is a wildlife filmmaker and photographer who, along with fellow co-director Heather Devey, wish to inspire us to learn and care about nature, particularly in our local settings with re-wilding as a thread and theme within their company.

Dan Turner became interested in birds at a young age and this interest has grown and developed with time. Since 1994 he has carried out annual surveys of the River Tyne nesting kittiwakes — recording the population changes at all known river sites. His illustrated presentation will focus on this period of study and show how the Tyne kittiwake population has changed and evolved. He has published five books, each of which features the Tyne, northeast England and some of its people and nature.
